Marriage Mentors

- 1) Marriage mentors receive training in mentoring other couples during a brief Friday evening and Saturday training program.
- 2) Marriage mentors commit to working with one or two assigned couples for 10 hours each over a three-month period.
- 3) During an introductory session, which all participants attend, the marriage mentors explain their availability to participants, explain the process, and assist with completing enrollment forms.
- 4) During the introductory session the marriage mentors also help participants define and prioritize goals and assist in determining if referrals to other outside resources seems necessary.

Workshop Speaker

- 1) Each workshop is led by an educational or motivational speaker and two (2) support personnel
- 2) At the workshop, the Columbus Marriage Coalition speaker will:
 - a) Engage audience to think about their marriage
 - b) Deliver content appropriate to the workshop
 - c) Present a true success story
 - d) Describe Columbus Marriage Coalition program
 - e) Close workshop by inviting participants to make a commitment to themselves

Site Coordinator

- 1) Host site assigns site coordinator
- 2) Site Coordinator attends an orientation session - forms are completed in “Host Site Organizational Packet”
- 3) Creates and submits “Site Marketing Plan” document to Susan Shockey
- 4) Schedules workshops by contacting Columbus Marriage Coalition co-coordinators
- 5) Recruits participants from their sites and/or their community to attend various Workshops
